<u>A WORD OF CAUTION AND FREEDOM</u>: Dear Saints of God, I want to remind you all that as Christians we are to follow our conscience, washed in Holy Baptism and made clean by the blood of Christ. We are not given to judge one another, neither in motive nor in action. In times such as our own—with heightened political tension, with weariness from various forms of lock-down, from economic distress, not to mention physical, mental, and spiritual suffering—we must pray for one another and forgive one another, bearing with one another the trials of this evil day. To that end, I want to remind you that there are various ways in which you might gather with the faithful here at Grace and Trinity—each of which can and ought to be done with a clear conscience before our Lord.

- We are blessed to gather with as many as so choose on Sunday mornings. Typically, at Grace we have about 30 each week, while at Trinity it's about 70. If 70 is too many for you, please feel welcome at Grace!
- Also, Grace offers a Wednesday morning Divine Service at 11am, at which about 15 regularly attend. That provides even more distancing.
- Finally, you're welcome to meet with me individually either in the sanctuary or your home and I'd be more than happy to accommodate.

The Lord has gifts to give. Please be sure to take part as your conscience and context provide.

<u>CONGREGATION AT PRAYER</u>: Daily prayer & devotion is vital. The half-page insert is for daily use in the home. We invite you to make use of it however you find it helpful. It can also be found on Grace's website.

<u>CORONAVIRUS PRECAUTIONS</u>: we're still observing some precautions of social distancing and a higher-sanitary reception of the Holy Sacrament. Until noted otherwise:

- Please sit in every other pew (not next to aisle);
- Make use of the hand-sanitizer at the entrance;
- Offerings will be collected in the Narthex;
- Communion will be offered in a single-file line by families to avoid touching the communion rails;
- We use more potent wine and use Everclear on the purificator to sanitize;
- No sharing of the peace prior to service;
- Please feel free to continue your fellowship outside, rather than in the Narthex, and keep spacing while departing the Sanctuary.

DAILY MATINS: This ancient morning prayer service is offered at Grace, **Mon-Fri at 9:00a.m**. Join us around our Lord's word, prayers for the Church, and singing beautiful hymnody. Live-streamed on Grace's FB page.

<u>SUNDAY BIBLE CLASS</u> is at 9:30am at Grace today. We're still working our way through Revelation. Join us!

<u>WEDNESDAY BIBLE CLASS</u>: meets at Grace at 9:30am. We're in St. Paul's first letter to the Thessalonians. Join us!

MIDWEEK ADVENT SERVICES: Wednesdays in December at Trinity we're preparing for the Lord's coming, *'advent'*, with a meal at 6pm and Compline at 7pm. We'll consider the Latin title for the week as preparation for the Lord's coming. Offerings support our Missionaries—the Conrads in Mexico City and Pastor Gaugert in the Congo.

WHAT'S THE BENEFIT OF LATIN AND GREEK in today's world? 60% of English words come from Latin and Greek, so knowing them helps with language arts. Latin is also the basis of Spanish, which will be taught at Concordia as well. In STEM subjects, 90% of the terminology comes from Latin and Greek. Latin and Greek grammar teaches logical thinking skills. They're two of the historical languages of the Church and are vital in studying Scripture and theology. Many great works of Western antiquity are in these languages; knowing them aids in the understanding of history and literature.
